- Until further notice, Sunday services will be held at 10:30 and 1:00. However, on July 19<sup>th</sup>, because of a previous commitment for the use of the fellowship hall, the afternoon service will be held at 4:00.
- We ask that everyone wear a face covering to enter and exit the church. We recommend that you wear your face covering during the service, but once you are seated in your pew, it will not be a requirement. The places where you may sit are clearly marked out in the pews and in the overflow area in order to ensure appropriate social distancing. Obviously, families from the same household may sit together.
- There will be no nursery provided.
- For obvious reasons we will need to avoid hugs, handshakes, fist bumps, and elbow taps.
- Also, the pew Bibles and hymnbooks have been removed. Hymns will be sung by song leaders, but not sung by the people in the congregation in order to avoid the spread of the virus.
- Bulletins are available for you to pick up near the entrance.
- The offering plates are at the entrance, so that you may place your offering in the plate either upon entering, or during the designated offering.
- As you enter and leave the building, we ask your cooperation. Please avoid congregating in groups not consistent with social distancing.
- Small groups such as committees and circles may resume their activities, with appropriate social distancing.
